Pre-Reading Activities

My Family Tree Art Project

- Age Range: 5-10
- Materials Needed: Large paper, markers/crayons, family photos (optional)
- Description: Have children draw their family tree, decorating it with-
 - Family members' names
 - Special symbols that represent what makes each person unique
 - Favorite memories with different family members

Feelings Discussion

- Age Range: 5-7
- Materials Needed: None
- **Description:** Talk about times when children felt nervous about a new experience but ended up enjoying it, connecting to the main character's journey.

During Reading Activities

Reunion Scavenger Hunt Checklist

- Age Range: 7-10
- Materials Needed: Printed checklists, pencils
- Description: As you read the book, have children create a list of-
 - Different activities happening at the reunion
 - Types of food mentioned
 - Various family members and their relationships
 - Signs of joy and celebration they spot in the illustrations

Emotion Detective

- **Age Range:** 5-7
- Materials Needed: Small mirrors (optional), space to move
- **Description:** Turn children into emotion detectives who investigate feelings through movement and expression-
 - Create a "feelings walk" where children move around the room showing different emotions from the story (excited, nervous, happy, surprised)
 - Play "freeze dance," where children freeze in poses that show how the main character felt at different parts of the story
 - Use mirrors (if available) to practice making faces that match different emotions mentioned in the book
 - Play "emotion charades." Children 'act out' feelings for others to guess
 - Create simple hand signals or gestures as a group to represent different emotions from the story
 - Use voice tone and volume to express how the main character might have spoken at different moments

Post-Reading Activities 1/2

Plan Your Dream Family Reunion

- Age Range: 8-10
- Materials Needed: Paper, art supplies
- Description: Have children design their ideal family gathering by-
 - Creating a menu of favorite family dishes
 - Planning fun activities for all ages
 - Drawing a map of where everything would take place
 - Making a schedule of events

Family Recipe Collection

- Age Range: 7-10
- Materials Needed: Recipe cards, writing materials
- Description: Have children-
 - Interview family members about their favorite recipes
 - Write or draw the ingredients
 - Record special memories associated with each dish
 - Create a mini family cookbook

Post-Reading Activities 2/2

Family Stories Recording Station

- Age Range: 5-10
- Materials Needed: Recording device (optional), paper, art supplies
- Description: Encourage children to-
 - Interview older family members about their favorite family stories
 - Draw pictures or take pictures to illustrate the stories
 - Create a family storybook with collected tales

Cultural Celebration Corner

- Age Range: 6-10
- Materials Needed: Various craft supplies
- **Description:** Help children explore and celebrate their family's cultural traditions through-
 - Creating family tradition collages
 - Learning traditional songs or games
 - Making cultural craft projects
 - Drawing/providing pictures of special celebration clothes or items

Extension Activities

Family News Reporter

- Age Range: 8-10
- Materials Needed: Paper, pencils, camera (optional)
- Description: Encourage children to-
 - Interview older family members about their favorite family stories
 - Writing short articles about family news
 - Including family jokes and fun facts
 - Adding photos or drawings

Memory Time Capsule

- Age Range: 5-10
- Materials Needed: Box or container, various materials for memories
- Description: Create a family reunion time capsule containing-
 - Photos
 - Written memories
 - Small mementos
 - Messages to future family members

Reflection Activities

Gratitude Journal

- **Age Range:** 7-10
- Materials Needed: Notebook, writing materials
- Description: Have children write or draw-
 - Three things they love about their family
 - Special moments they want to remember
 - Things they learned about their family history
 - New family members they met

Assessment Ideas for Educators

- Have students create a presentation about their family traditions
- Write a story about their own family gathering
- Create a compare/contrast chart between the book's family reunion and their own experiences
- Design a family reunion invitation incorporating elements from the story

Tips for Implementation

- Adapt activities based on age and ability level
- Be sensitive to different family structures and situations
- Encourage creativity and personal expression
- Make modifications as needed for virtual or distance learning
